At the very outset I would like to extend a warm welcome to our Chairman Mahant Surjit Singh and all other Trust Members for having spared their valuable time to grace the occasion, we are grateful to you Sir.

I also would like to express my sincere gratitude for their unstinted support without which the school would not have achieved the results which it is witnessing today as one of the oldest, biggest and most successful schools of the region.

The school is doing a yeoman service since its inception by providing quality education to the rural populace at an affordable cost. It is one of the oldest CBSE Schools of the region. The school is alumnus to a number of students who have carved a niche not only for themselves but also to the school in all walks of life in India as well as abroad.

The Alumni of the School are spread over in all professions like Doctors (one of the Schools having largest numbers of doctors), Engineers, Lawyers, bureaucrat, Armed forces, Politicians (the local MLA product of the School), Businessman, and Farmers etc and excelled not only in India but abroad also.

The school has been providing invaluable exposure to students in a large number of co-curricular activities, sports and games at District, State, National and CBSE levels. The complete Academic Curriculum of the school has been designed for all round development of their personality, imbibe life skills, improve their communication skills and build their character. It has been a constant endeavor to equip the students with knowledge and skills to make them better citizens and meet all future challenges successfully.

Academics:-

The academic curriculum in the school is designed in tune with the CBSE guidelines. Emphasis given on innovative Pedagogical methods to ensure improved learning abilities amongst the students in a stress free and conducive environment. The School follows a comprehensive evaluation system for better learning abilities. A total of three periodic tests, Half Yearly are conducted for classes from IX to XII apart from final/board exam and for others it is two unit tests, Half Yearly and final Exams.

A total of six Parent Teacher Meetings are structured every year for interaction of Parents with all teachers. In this four are conducted after every exam and two PTM well before the Half Yearly and Final Exams to apprise the Parents of their wards performance and measures instituted for their better performance. In addition to the

structured PTMs, every second Saturday of the month is devoted for PTM from 1200h to 1500 h.

As a general rule the students are not detained in the same class except exceptional cases at lower classes. In the class X Board Examinations the School has achieved 100% result. A total of 254 Students have appeared in the Class X exam and total of 11 have received more than 90%.

In class XII a total of 168 students have appeared in the examination in Medical, Non-Medical and Commerce streams. Only 05 students have failed / got Compartment with pass percentage at 97%. Ms Tanu Goyal D/o Mr Sukhwinder Goyal of Class XII, Non Medical Stream topped the District of Barnala with 97.4%. She is also an NTSE, KVPY scholar and topped the prestigious JEE advanced Exam from Roorkee Zone among girls with an all India Rank of 263. Presently she is pursuing B.Tech(CSE) from IIT, Mumbai.

Co Curricular Activities:-

All Students are encouraged and given adequate exposure to participate in various co curricular activities to showcase their innate talents. During Parent Teacher Meeting Science, Maths, Social Science and Art Exhibitions are conducted. A large number of co curricular activities are conducted as given in the calendar throughout the academic year. These co curricular activities inculcate and improve, creative and analytical thinking, mental abilities, communication skills, group tasks, innovative ideas, organizational abilities, leadership qualities etc.

The competitions are conducted as given in the academic calendar as inter house and inter class events. Every student is encouraged and given an opportunity to participate. Shabad gyan and Turban tying competitions are organized to imbibe values and spiritual path amongst children. The year 2019 being the year of 550 Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev Ji the School celebrated Guru Nanak Dev Ji's 550 Birth Anniversary with Shabad Gyan, performed both by students and professionals. Lectures and discourses on the life of Guru Nanak Dev ji were organized with display exhibits on the life and teachings of Shri Guru Nanak Dev ji followed by Langar for Parents, Staff and Students. All meritorious students of the academic year 2018-19 were given prizes during the function.

Large number of activities are organized for the children of Primary Wing including Fancy dress competitions in the presence of Parents. The academic Curriculum at Primary Wing is imparted with emphasis on activity based learning.

A large numbers of events are also organized on specific days of importance and as per the CBSE guidelines like Swacchta Day, Children's Day, Yoga Day, Teachers

Day, Independence Day, Republic Day, Science Day etc. The Students have also taken up Social Campaigns like Swacchta Week, ODF Campaign, Drug Free Society, empowering Girl Child, National Integration and they performed street plays, gave lectures and interacted with locals at Barnala, Pharwahi, Sekha, Tapa and Sanghera villages.

The students of Class IX, X, XI and XII participated in CBSE Regional level Science Exhibition held at Green Field School, Ludhiana and Exhibited their Exhibits in Hydroponics and Water conservation and won acclaim from one and all.

Sports and Games:-

Inter House Sports competitions in Football, Handball, Basketball, Badminton, Chess, Athletics are held as per the school calendar under various categories for both boys as well as girls.

Students under various categories for various sporting events were selected and represented at Cluster, District, State and National Championships.

A total of 122 students got selected to represent at the district level under various categories in Badminton, Football, Handball, Cricket, Basketball, Swimming, Shooting, Chess, table Tennis, Skating, Netball. A total of 30 Students got selected for state events in Football, Basketball, Chess, Badminton, and Handball. Master Jobanpreet Singh S/o Hav Sukhwinder Singh got selected for sub Junior Nationals in 10 meter peep sight shooting competition and Ms Shreya D/o Davinder Singh got selected for roller skating and participated at National roller skating championship at Vizag, A.P.

Educational Tour:-

All students of the school are sent on educational tour to places of interest. Children of Primary Wing were sent to Amusement Park in Ludhiana, Students of Class VI & VII were sent to Amusement Park in Chandigarh, students of VIII and IX were sent to Adventure Park Phagwara and Students of Class X to XII were sent to Science City, Jalandhar.

A carnival of fun games and water theme park were organized for the tiny tots within the school campus.

NCC:-

The school has Junior Division of NCC with 100 cadets of both boys and girls enrolled in it. Parade for the Cadets is conducted weekly twice within the School Campus by Service Personnel of 20 NCC Bn, Bathinda. A total of 45 Cadets have

participated in the Annual Training Camp held at Ropar and all students of class X will appear for NCC A' certificate at Bathinda.

Infrastructure:-

A large number of classrooms and verandahs have been tiled in the Primary and Senior wings. A new 10 mtr shooting range has been constructed. All the three assembly areas have been improved. New lawn cutters, Sports equipment and large number of Library Books were procured.

Teaching- Learning is a complex process involving Teachers, Students and Resource material. It has been an Endeavour at the school to make the whole process of Teaching-Learning stress free by involving innovative pedagogical tools and techniques. The school has gone from strength to strength and concerted efforts will be made in taking it further to greater heights.
